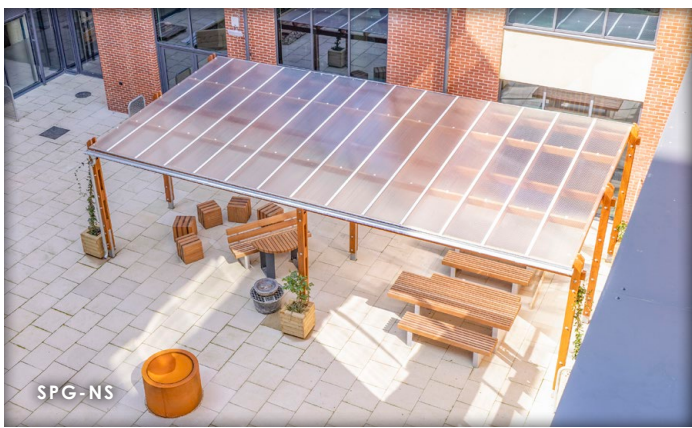

Specified by ADP Architecture, we produced an external canopy to provide cover for the students in the newly landscaped area. Made from FSC-certified Hardwood Iroko, this gives the structure a premium feel, amalgamating the high-quality timber finish with the rest of the newly constructed East Slope area. The use of a clear polycarbonate roof ensures a well-lit area while still giving shelter from the elements. External canopies are now becoming a crucial requirement to all new and existing education projects. As pupil numbers continue to grow in the UK ahead of the school construction rate, these areas are an affordable way to extend the school, college, or universities useable external areas.
