We manufactured and installed a number of our Sheldon SST300 Seats made with Treated Class 4 Redwood & galvanised steel legs to provide formal seating facilities for both residents and visitors. We also provided our Sheldon SPL316 Planter with integral benching, offering additional casual seating to the schemes beautifully landscaped external spaces. Finally our bespoke manufacturing capabilities enabled us to produce a striking feature pergola sitting prominently in the new courtyard area. The addition of tensile wires to the pergola top allows climbing plants to grow around the structure, adding a touch of colour to the area whilst also offering some shading during the summer months.
