The dark flint is usually set facing outwards and arranged to create different patterns, but it is often common practice for a few flints to be turned inwards with their white skins showing. In addition to the standard stock size, we can supply whole flints and a range of different quantities to suit your individual requirements and other colours are available on request.

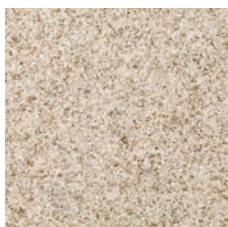

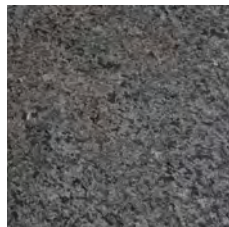
