It is recommended not to use gravel types with a size of less than 4mm; finer gravels could stick to people's shoes or get between the profiles on the tyres of a car. For an optimum compaction in the honeycomb, we recommend limiting the maximum diameter of the gravel to 16mm.

The sheets support the use of rounded pebbles and most decorative aggregates. Please see our Aggregates and Gravels on page 85.

ECCOgravel30 or ECCOgravel40?

Choose the right product for your intended use. It's vital to think about how your gravel area will be used – consider what loads, traffic and people can be expected to walk or travel over the area.

ECCOgravel sheets have a very high compressive strength in an unfilled state. Allowing gravel to travel underneath the sheets should be avoided at all costs. Each sheet is extremely lightweight so no special lifting equipment is required and the sheets can be easily cut into shape with a power or hand saw. Sheet sizes are 1.6m x 1.2m, sheets can be folded in half for easy transportation.

ECCOgravel40 is ideal for driveways, low-speed access roads, car parks and emergency lanes.

With a height of 40mm, ECCOgravel40 can handle occasional heavy traffic however tight u-turns by trailers or similar vehicles should be avoided if possible. It makes a graveled surface more suitable for pedestrians, pushchairs and bikes.

Installation:

Additional technical information can be found on our website at www.cedstone.co.uk along with frequently asked questions, gravel choice and sub-base recommendations.



1. Perform the necessary excavation. Always remove the top soil.



2. Install the borders.
These should be 20mm above the level of the top of the sheet.



3. Install the sub-base in layers not exceeding 200mm depth and compact with a roller or vibrating plate.



4. Install the levelling layer and then level and compact.



5. Cut sheets with a cutting disc then lay in half-brick bond, making sure you overlap the geotextile underside on each sheet.



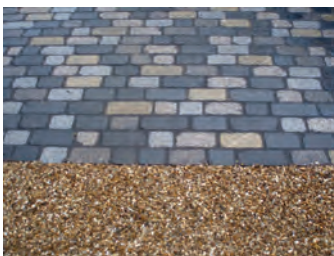
6. Make any necessary cuts using a power or hand saw to form any shape required.



7. Pour the gravel directly over the laid sheets and spread evenly with a rake, shovel or broom, making sure all the cells are filled.



8. As the gravel begins to settle, make sure the cells are filled with the correct amount so that the sheets are not visible underneath.



9. ECCOgravel 30 requires 30mm, ECCOgravel40 40mm of gravel to fill the cells, and an additional 10mm is needed over the top to cover the surface.



10. Inspect and level a few weeks after installation. Add additional gravel where necessary.

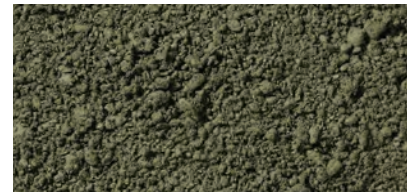

CEDEC Footpath Gravels form a firm but porous structure that retains moisture while allowing any excess water to flow through.

CEDEC's combination of different graded aggregates create a firm, packed surface with approx. 25% compaction, which is still porous and retains moisture due to its reduced clay content.

Made from granite or quartzite, CEDEC is tree-friendly and does not affect the soil's pH balance.

After compaction, coverage of CEDEC footpath gravel, is approximately 10m² per tonne at 50mm thick, compaction being about 25%.

So to compact to 50mm an initial non-compacted layer of 65mm is required.

Product Description

Consisting of selected limestone graded from 14mm to fine particles, this product has a high content of naturally occurring marl which results in exceptional self-binding properties and a non-porous surface. Because Golden Amber Footpath Gravel is limestone based, it can affect the pH levels in the soil.

Hoggin



Product Description

Hoggin is a well-graded gravel consisting of a precise mix of clay, sand and gravel. The clay acts as a binder, and helps to form an effective, very stable surface when Hoggin is compacted. This makes it only slightly permeable, allowing most rainfall to run off the surface, making it a great material to use for footpaths.

While our CEDEC® range has been a popular product since the 1990's there were awkward situations when it was not the ideal product to use. As a result we developed SuperCEDEC® which is more flexible and easier to compact, making it particularly suitable for treepits.

This product has the same natural appearance and permeability as CEDEC, but has a firmer compaction and slightly looser crumb on the surface. Both CEDEC and SuperCEDEC footpath gravels are made from granite and quartzite materials, which will not affect the pH value of the surrounding soil and cause damage to growing trees.

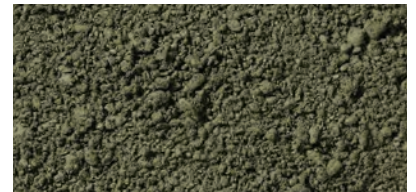

After compaction, coverage of SuperCEDEC, either in tree pits or as a footpath gravel, is approximately 10m² per tonne at 50mm thick, compaction being about 25%.

So, in order to compact to 50mm, an initial non-compacted layer of 65mm is required.

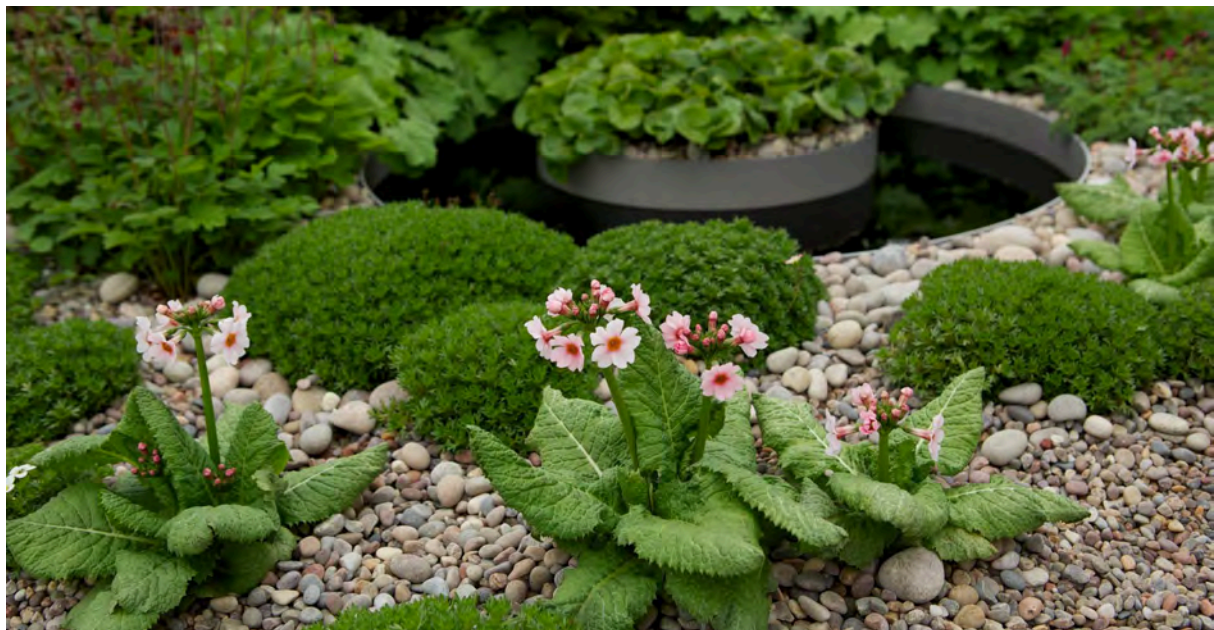

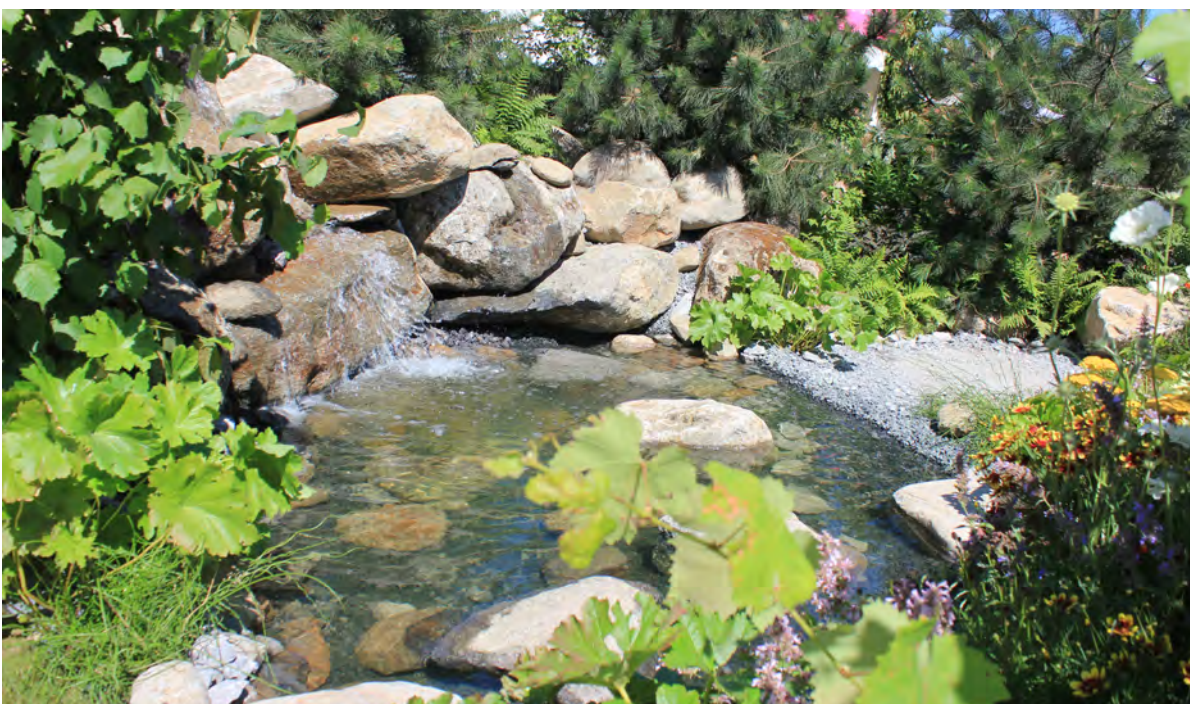
No two boulders are ever the same, so we suggest that you take your time to pick one that's the right size, shape and colour for your scheme.

Larger boulders will of course have more of an impact in your design, while a cluster of smaller boulders will create a more subtle look.

Natural stone transforms when wet, and this is no exception with boulders. Make sure you look at how the boulders will change in the rain or under water fountains, and assess whether this will still work with your chosen colour palette.

When positioning your boulders, think about burying a small portion of the stone base beneath the ground to make them look 'grown in' and natural.

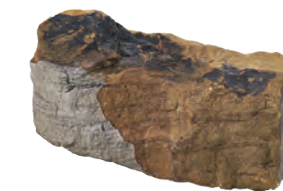

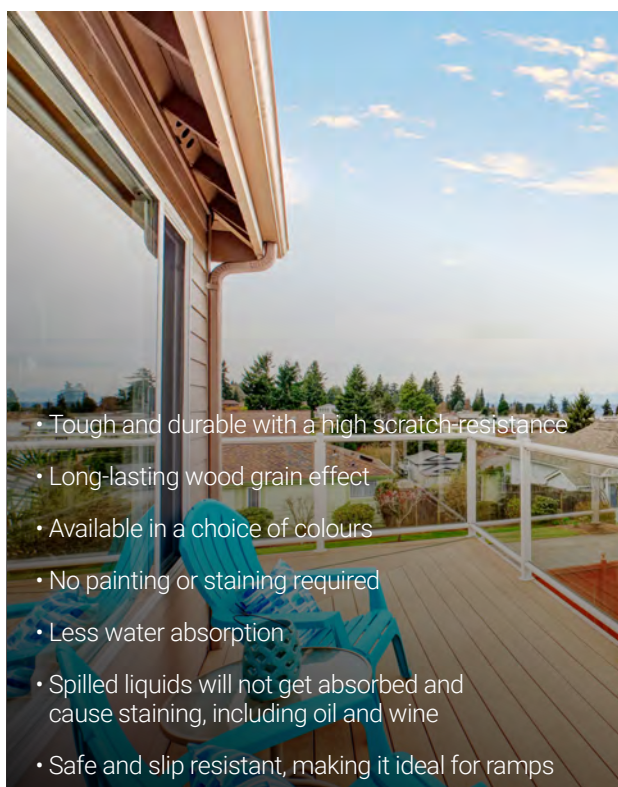

Despite this protective barrier however, there are some common contaminants that will still cause staining:

- Greasy food from BBQs
- Drinks such as red wine or coffee
- Vehicle oil spills
- Tyre marks
- Algae, lichens and other naturally occurring stains

Choosing the right care products for your paving is vital; overly aggressive cleaning regimes can strip the stone's natural protective layer, rendering it vulnerable again to fresh staining and marks.

When using any chemical on natural stone, we recommend testing the product on an off-cut or inconspicuous section of your paving first, to ensure that you are familiar with how the product works and to double check there are no adverse effects from its use.

Bullnose Edging

A stone with a rounded, curved edge that's ideal for stone and porcelain steps, benches, wall copings, pool surrounds, planter tops, pier caps and other ledges. Bullnosing reduces the risk of chips and creates an attractive, contemporary style.

For bullnose pier caps and wall copings in particular, our masonry teams will include drip grooves which will catch moisture and rain droplets. This will help to avoid water damage, wall staining and frost-heave on the coping stones. We can also produce stones with a half bullnose, regency, cove or chamfer edge, depending on your custom design.



Cutting

Paving shouldn't come in set sizes – we are able to take your bespoke measurements and cut your chosen material into the perfect length or shape. Using our specialist tools and techniques, we can cut paving slabs, radius kerbs, edging and even rocks or boulders to make them just the right size for your unique project.

We're also able to cut any of our natural stone or porcelain paving materials into specific shapes, using advanced water jet cutters.

Ideal for creating paving circles, commemorative headstones, curved step treads, artistic wall panelling, water features, shaped stepping stones and geometric paving slabs, your made-to-order design will be cut with perfect precision and care.



Cropping

Cropping is a splitting technique which is used to break down larger natural stone products into smaller ones, for example when cropping larger rectangular paving setts into cubes.

Using a specialist cropping machine, the technique naturally splits the stone, creating a rough, rustic side or surface.

Cropping is a great technique to use for resizing reclaimed materials, when a neatly sawn edge might spoil the rustic, aged appearance.



Drilling

We can drill holes into any type of natural stone product, no matter the size or thickness. This simple technique allows for a range of bespoke stone creations.

Create a patio perfect for evening entertaining, with outdoor lighting set into carefully drilled holes in paving slabs. Cobbles and boulders can be cored and fed through a steel support pole to create a stacked 'stone balancing' sculpture.

Peep holes can be drilled into the sides of a feature stone for a modern contemporary art installation. The possibilities are endless!



Sandblasting

Sandblasting erodes the surface of the stone to leave a rough, non-slip texture by using high-pressured jets of abrasive-laden water, and works well on sedimentary stones such as sandstone or limestone.

Although all of our paving has a safe slip resistance rating, sandblasting can be an effective technique to use on sandstone and limestone paving designated for particularly high slip risk areas, such as pool surrounds or spas.

Sandblasting is also used to add a roughened texture to the edge of steps or coping stones, but can also be used to create a worn look.



Flame Texturing

Resulting in a premium look, flaming is a more suitable technique to use for giving texture to igneous materials like granites (excluding Yellow Granite) and basalts.

Applying a high temperature flame 'scorches' and fractures the crystals on the surface of the stone, creating a coarse, slip resistant texture.

Flaming the surface will still show the true colours of the natural stone, making it an ideal technique for creating beautiful non-slip paving, bullnose steps, coping stones and pool surrounds.

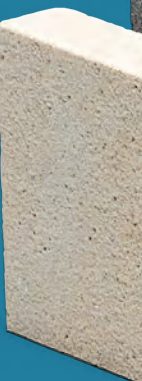
