



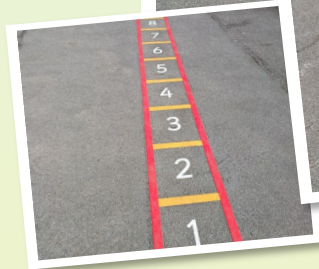

I first visited the school about 18 months ago. The Playground had nothing on it apart from a netball court marking. The client was massively keen to add some “play value” to the area but in general, the condition of the tarmac was poor. We discussed the best options for them and selected the only available areas for laying the new markings.
