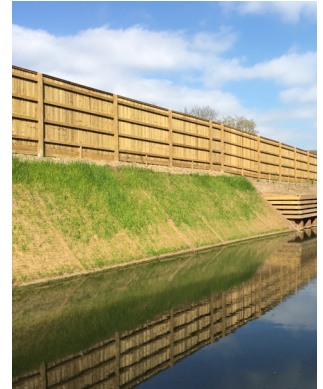


Which Covamat™ Do I Need?

Covamat Plus

Covamat™ Plus improves poor soil conditions due to the incorporation of a specially developed organic fertilisers and dry micro-organisms. This seed, fertiliser and dry micro-organism combination helps to guarantee the best possible germination results for the grass seed within the blankets. The mulch layer is a combination of coir-dust, chopped Straw, chopped Hay and coir-waste for seed embedment and vegetation enhancement.

Covamat Plus is our standard pre-seeded erosion control blanket and is suitable for most applications. When speaking to Greenfix please confirm the degree of slope and if the product will be installed close to any bodies of water.



Covamat Fresh

Covamat Fresh provides the same benefits as the Covamat Plus however the Fresh has an additional 5mm layer of topsoil. The additional layer of topsoil allows the seeds to commence germination once the rolls are manufactured. Due to this Covamat Fresh required immediate installation upon delivery.

Covamat Fresh is ideal for use in areas with hard to establish soil or shaded areas. When speaking to Greenfix please confirm the degree of slope and if the product will be installed close to any bodies of water.



Degree of Slope

Type 1: 100% straw blanket suitable for slopes up to 30 degrees

Type 2: 50% straw & 50% coir blanket suitable for slopes up to 45 degrees

Type 3: 100% coir blanket suitable for slopes over 45 degrees. If the product is to be use close to any bodies of water we would recommend the Type 3 blanket.

Covamat Maintenance

If the weather is dry for a long period of time watering may be required, especially in the early stages of root development. For successful germination and grass establishment the blankets must be in contact with the underlying soil. A level, weed and debris free surface is required. Do not stretch the blanket during installation and install additional pins if required to achieve good contact with the soil below. Re-pin any loose or damaged areas as part of your maintenance check. For more installation information please see our Covamat Installation Guide.
