■ GROWTH

Harrowden Woodland Shade Meadowmat® Seed Mix is a blend of 6 slow growing grasses and 31 native and traditional wildflowers many of which can be found growing in woodland and hedgerows. All but one of the species are perennial which means they will flower every year if the conditions are suitable. The specially selected grasses ensure coverage all year round.
